IMET2000 Organised Its 3rd Annual Conference on Clinical Audit and Research



We were pleased to have been able to organise our 3rd Annual Conference on Clinical Audit and Research in Palestine. This meeting, opened by his Excellency Prof. Abu Mowis the Minister of Higher Education and Research, featured several themes on clinical audit and research in Palestine. Our founder Prof Green highlighted in a keynote presentation the Palestinian experience of delivering research with limited resources as a unique model that can be adopted globally particularly in areas of conflict. Dr Al-Khateeb, Dr Nazal and Dr El-Essi among others delivered keynote talks that reflected outstanding efforts on the front of clinical research in Palestine. Dr Zaben, our CEO announced the launch of our Palestinian Research Club as a forum under which Palestinian researchers can come together to collaborate and deliver their projects of interest. This forum will be funded by IMET2000. We were very pleased to see many high-quality abstracts presented. Three prizes were awarded to the best oral presentations. We are looking forward to your abstracts next year at our 4th Annual Conference.



IMET2000 in Collaboration with PMSA Organised a Hands-on Workshop on How to Do a Clinical Audit

As part of our work to promote clinical research in Palestine, we have organised an online workshop on how to conduct a clinical audit. This was organised through our partnership with PMSA. The workshop was led by our CEO, Dr. Malik Zaben and attended by about 40 students.

These workshops were attended by 22 doctors from different hospitals in the West-Bank at Najah life support training centre in An-Najah National University and IMET training centre. the aim of these workshops is to learn about Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for healthcare professionals, Automated External Defibrillation (AED) and First Aid.
