Another Successful ATLS Course at IMET2000-Pal Training Centre

We have organised our 7th ATLS training course in Ramallah. This was delivered by our Palestinian ATLS instructors (Dr Ahmad Dalbah, Dr Dirar Zatari, and Dr Murad Karajeh) and we are glad to have been joined by new instructors (Dr Amer AbuRumaila and Dr Mohammed Bakeer). The course was opened by our ATLS director Dr Fahmi Jubran and coordinator Mr Fadi Zaben. This particular course remarks a collaboration with the Department of Emergency Services at the Ministry of Health- Dr Qawasmeh paid the centre a visit and thanked IMET2000 for their support. In this course, 12 doctors from Governmental and Non-Governmental hospitals all over the West Bank were trained as per the ATLS curriculum. This course is well-recognised for training healthcare staff to coordinate and manage trauma cases effectively. Dr Malik Zaben, IMET2000 CEO said “We aim to continue working with other Palestinian stakeholders to deliver more ATLS courses until we get as many surgeons as possible trained in this vital field. We are looking to expand this course to involve ATLS for nurses and medical students and hopefully to other areas in Palestine.

These workshops aim to train on Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for healthcare professionals, Automated External Defibrillation (AED) and First Aid and they were led by certified instructors from American Heart Association.

IMET2000 Organised Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support Training Workshop at IMET2000-Pal Training Centre

IMET2000-Pal held a workshop covering advanced cardiopulmonary resuscitation attended by 6 doctors and nurses from different hospitals. It was titled:

Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Course for Physicians and Nurses

The workshop was opened by Dr Fajr Sarhan who welcomed the attendees and outlined different events organised by IMET2000. The workshop was directed by Dr Farid Abu Iel a reliable instructor from the American Heart Association. The training involved the use of medical dolls which helped educate the trainees on how to perform advanced cardiac resuscitation on patients that needed immediate aid and allowed them to practice it. This was alongside a scientific and practical explanation provided by the instructors. At the end of the second day, the trainees were assessed to measure their ability to deal with such cases.

IMET2000 Re-newed Dr Belal Al Gomri Scholarship, a Plastic Surgery Resident at Al-Mansoura University

Dr Belal has accomplished many educational and clinical goals in the field of plastic surgery, burns and tissue reconstruction. He has carried out many simple and complex operations, like the complete reconstruction of lost tissues, connecting amputated parts through microscopic surgeries, as well as dealing with cases of facial and jaw fractures in emergency units and complex burn cases.

He also participated in 490 various operations performed during 2022. He was a primary surgeon in 143 operations and the rest as an assistant surgeon. Among the most important of these operations are breast reconstruction, cleft lip, reshaping ear, excision of facial tumours and tissue reconstruction, birth defects and skin transplantation.
