September 24th, 2023, IMET2000-Pal in cooperation with An-Najah National University organised a workshop titled:

Paediatrics Advanced Life Support (PALS) Provider Training for Doctors

This workshop was attended by 6 Participants from different governmental and private hospitals at An-Najah Training Centre-Nablus. This workshop aims to discuss the important issues regarding PALS, focusing on the updates of American PALS, 2020, the practice of the paediatric systematic approach, the practice of high-quality CPR (Basic Life Support) for children, giving respiratory and cardiac emergencies and early interventions. Finally, shows Multi-rescuer resuscitation and team dynamics.

It was led by our Representative in Palestine, Mr Fady Zaben; a certified instructor by the American Heart Association.
