The International Medical Education Trust 2000 held a Basic Life Support (BLS) Training for Doctors and Nurses from Al-Amal Hospital in Jenin



In response to the current situation and the difficult conditions and incursions Jenin city is facing, IMET2000 has started providing scholarships for students and medical staff from Jenin since last year, in addition to signing agreements with various hospitals in the city to support and enhance the medical staff's skills in effectively dealing with injuries, especially in light of the repeated incursions into the city by the occupation forces.

Following the support provided by IMET2000 to the city of Jenin and fulfilling the agreement recently signed with Al-Amal Hospital in Jenin, IMET2000, in cooperation with the Arab American University, conducted a BLS training for doctors and nurses from Al-Amal Hospital on Saturday, April 6, 2024, at the Arab American University in Jenin. The training was attended by 3 doctors, 5 nurses, and one midwife, nurse.



IMET2000 Renews Support for Children with Special Needs from the Al Riyadh Charitable Society for Children with Disabilities



IMET2000 supports the Al Riyadh Charitable Society in Salfit for the third consecutive year to cover the treatment expenses of another 10 Palestinian children in 2024 to help Al Riyadh with their mission of looking after children with learning disabilities, mental disorders, and autism. Al Riyadh is a charity that provides rehabilitation services for children with disabilities from Salfit, mostly from poor families who cannot pay for their children's treatment. Their services include physical, occupational, and speech therapy, all essential for integrating this disadvantaged group of children into society.

We hope to continue working with Al Riyadh and other similar charities, such as the Early Intervention Charitable Society, to provide access to as many kids with physical and mental disabilities as we can, regardless of their financial status.



The International Medical Education Trust 2000 facilitates Clinical Attachments for Palestinian doctors in UK Hospitals



As part of enhancing medical education and international cooperation, the International Medical Education Trust 2000 has supported and contributed to providing clinical training for four Palestinian doctors in UK hospitals. Dr Omar Awadallah from Bethlehem, Dr Taysir Allawneh from Qalqilya, and Dr Mohammad Qasrawi from Jenin have commenced their clinical training in internal medicine, while Dr Yasri Abdel Hafez from Qalqilya has started his training in orthopaedic surgery at St. Helier Hospital in London.

IMET2000-Pal Signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Friends Medical for Health Creativity



IMET2000-Pal signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Friends Medical for Health Creativity at the IMET2000-Pal Training Centre in Ramallah on April 4th.

This agreement comes within the framework of supporting and implementing joint programmes to develop clinical skills in various trainings and workshops.



The memorandum focuses on IMET2000 adopting the Friends Medical for Health Creativity as a site for Basic Life Support (BLS), Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS), and Paediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) training since the Friends Medical for Health Creativity is an accredited life support centre approved by the American Heart Association (AHA).



IMET2000 Organised Three Basic Life Support Training Workshops in this Month



IMET2000-Pal, in cooperation with the Arab American University, Friends Medical for Health Creativity, and the Modern University Collage Heart Centres, organised THREE training workshops attended by 27 doctors and nurses from governmental and private hospitals on:

Critical Core Training: Basic Life Support (BLS) training for Healthcare Professionals

The workshops took place at the IMET2000-Pal Training Centre and Military Medical Unit. These trainings aimed to provide instructions and practical sessions about adult, child, and infant Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) for healthcare professionals and Automated External Defibrillation (AED). They were led by certified instructors from the American Heart Association (AHA).
