



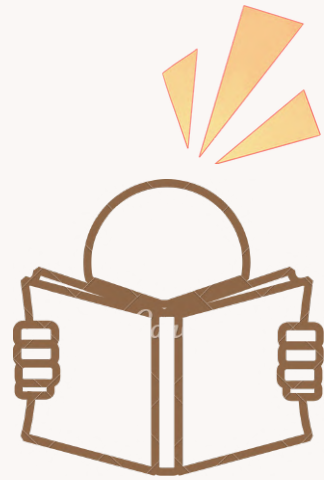

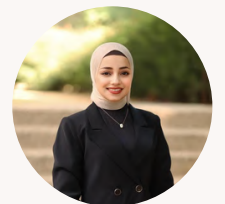

IMET2000 Organised Trauma Evaluation and Management (TEAM) Training in Collaboration with Palestinian Medical Students' Association

IMET2000-Pal has supported the Palestinian Medical Students' Association (PMSA) through training grants for its participants in the Trauma Evaluation and Management (TEAM) programme, which focuses on injury assessment and management and is accredited by the American College of Surgeons. The training was held at the IMET2000- Pal Training Centre on Friday, 5/7/2024, and was attended by 16 medical students. It was conducted under the supervision of Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS) instructors.

The session addressed incidents that demand rapid injury assessment and appropriate interventions to save patients' lives.

The workshop employed comprehensive simulations based on real-life scenarios and followed the recommendations of the American College of Surgeons.

As a result of the training, participants acquired the ability to promptly and accurately assess the conditions of injured patients. They also learned to determine the correct priorities for assessing and resuscitating patients. Furthermore, participants gained experience in collaborative care for injured patients during their transfer to the hospital.



IMET2000 Organised Two Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) Training Workshops at IMET2000-Pal Training Centre

IMET2000-Pal organised two training workshops covering advanced cardiopulmonary resuscitation on 15,16/7/2024 and 29/7/2024 attended by 14 doctors and nurses from different hospitals. The workshops were titled: **Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Course for Physicians and Nurses.**

IMET2000 implemented these training workshops at IMET2000-Pal Training Centre which aimed to train participants on crucial aspects such as managing respiratory and cardiac arrest, symptomatic bradycardia, airway and stroke management, and relevant pharmacology. Additionally, it emphasized fostering effective communication and leadership skills within an ACLS team.

The training, conducted by a certified instructor from the Arab American University (AAUP) - American Heart Association, involved the use of medical dolls for hands-on practice in advanced cardiac resuscitation techniques. The session concluded with an assessment to gauge the trainees' proficiency in handling emergency cases.

IMET2000-Pal organised two training workshops attended by 18 doctors and nurses from governmental and private hospitals on: **Critical Core Training: Basic Life Support (BLS) Training for Healthcare Professionals.**

The workshops took place at the IMET2000-Pal Training Centre and An-Najah Heart Training Centre.

These trainings aimed to provide instructions and practical sessions about adult, children and infants Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) for healthcare professionals and Automated External Defibrillation (AED).

They were led by certified instructors from the An-Najah National University and the Modern University Collage Heart Centres - American Heart Association (AHA).

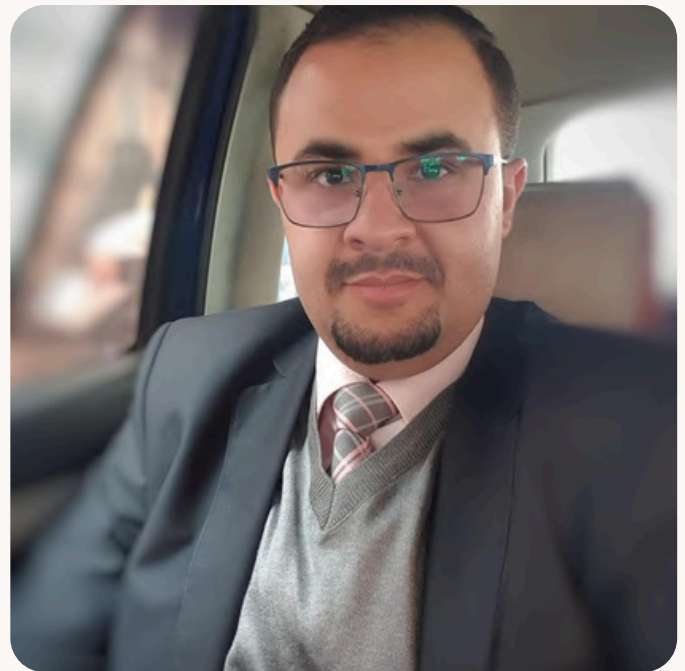


IMET2000 Renews Support for Psychiatry Scholars at Jordan University of Science and Technology

Within the framework of mental health projects supported by the International Medical Education Trust 2000 (IMET2000), and as part of the priorities of the grants offered by IMET2000, IMET2000 has sponsored Dr. Majed Al-Alami from Gaza and Dr. Mamoun Basila from Hebron to specialise in the field of Psychiatry at the Jordan University of Science and Technology (JUST) and King Abdullah Hospital. This specialisation is part of the educational programmes focused on mental health offered by IMET2000, the programme granting a full scholarship for five years in Jordan, followed by a training year in child psychiatry in the UK.
