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IMET2000 Organises IMET-R Workshop to Advance Research Skills

As part of its commitment to strengthening research capacity among Palestinian healthcare professionals, IMET2000 organised the Inspiring Medical Excellence through Research (IMET-R) workshop from 5-7 July 2026 at the IMET2000-Pal Training Centre in Ramallah.

The three-day programme brought together newly graduated doctors, nurses, and clinical medical students for interactive lectures and practical training led by Prof Malik Zaben, CEO of IMET2000, and Dr Ahmed Rajoub, Medical Education Officer at IMET2000-Pal. The workshop covered the essential stages of scientific research, including research design, literature review, proposal development, data analysis, scientific writing, research ethics, and academic publishing.



Through the IMET-R programme, IMET2000 continues to foster a culture of research and evidence-based practice, equipping the next generation of healthcare professionals with the skills needed to contribute to innovation and improve healthcare in Palestine.

IMET2000 Equips Palestinian Paramedics with Essential Trauma Evaluation and Management Skills

Recognising the critical role of paramedics in the first moments after injury, IMET2000-Pal organised the Trauma Evaluation and Management (TEAM™) course, accredited by the American College of Surgeons (ACS), on 16 July 2026 at the IMET2000-Pal Training Centre in Ramallah.

The course brought together 16 paramedics and emergency medical technicians from the Palestinian EMTs & Paramedics Council across the West Bank. Delivered by Dr Amer Abu Rumaila and Dr Hisham Ibrahim, certified ATLS® instructors, the training focused on the principles of rapid trauma assessment and early management, equipping participants with practical, evidence-based skills to provide effective pre-hospital care.

By strengthening the capabilities of frontline ambulance professionals, IMET2000 continues to support higher standards of emergency care in Palestine, ensuring injured patients receive timely, life-saving interventions when every second counts.



IMET2000 Provides "Stop the Bleed" Course for Nursing Students at Bethlehem University



In an inspiring step towards preparing future nurses with the essential skills needed to manage life-threatening bleeding in emergencies, IMET2000-Pal conducted a specialised “Stop the Bleed” course, accredited by the American College of Surgeons (ACS), for nursing students on 23 July at the Qubeiba campus of Bethlehem University.

The course combined theoretical knowledge with practical hands-on training, allowing students to practise bleeding control techniques using high-fidelity mannequins. Participants received training on essential interventions, including direct wound compression, wound packing, and proper tourniquet application.

The training was delivered by Dr Fady Zaben, IMET2000-Pal representative and an accredited instructor from the ACS, ensuring high-quality education aligned with international standards.

Students expressed their appreciation to IMET2000 for the specialised training, highlighting its practical value in strengthening their confidence and skills in controlling severe bleeding.



IMET2000 and Hakini Company Sign Partnership to Strengthen Mental Health in Palestine

IMET2000-Pal has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Hakini, a leading digital mental health platform, to strengthen collaboration in mental health education and professional training in Palestine.



The partnership will focus on developing and delivering specialised training programmes for healthcare professionals, enhancing clinical skills, and supporting joint initiatives that promote high-quality mental health services. By combining expertise, both organisations aim to expand access to professional development opportunities and contribute to improving mental health care for Palestinian communities.



The agreement was signed at IMET2000-Pal's office in Ramallah by Dr Fady Zaben, IMET2000 Representative in Palestine, and Ms Sundus Mlitat, Chief Executive Officer of Hakini, in the presence of representatives from both parties.

IMET2000 Delivers Advanced Cardiac Life Support Training for Healthcare Professionals

IMET2000-Pal hosted a training workshop on advanced cardiopulmonary resuscitation on July 20-21, 2026, attended by seven doctors and nurses from various hospitals. The workshop was titled:

"Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Course for Healthcare Professionals"

This training workshop was conducted at the IMET2000-Pal Training Centre, focusing on critical emergency topics including the management of respiratory and cardiac arrest, symptomatic bradycardia, airway and stroke management, and related pharmacology. The workshop also emphasised enhancing communication and leadership skills within an ACLS team.

The course was conducted by a certified instructor from the Arab American University, Palestine - American Heart Association. Participants engaged in hands-on practice using simulation manikins to strengthen their advanced cardiac resuscitation skills. The workshop concluded with a formal assessment to evaluate participants' competency in managing emergency and critical care situations.



IMET2000 Partners with Khaled Charitable Society to Support People with Severe Disabilities



People with severe disabilities require specialised care and support that addresses their needs. Recognising the importance of strengthening services for individuals with severe disabilities, IMET2000-Pal has signed a cooperation agreement with Khaled Society for Severe Disability in Ramallah to promote mental health support, training, and capacity building.

Through this partnership, both charities will collaborate to enhance the quality of services provided to people with severe disabilities, support professionals working with them, and contribute to improving their well-being and inclusion.

The agreement was signed at the IMET2000-Pal centre in Ramallah. Khaled Society for Severe Disability was represented by Ms Layali Al-Daghma, President of the Society, Mr Naji Al-Qadi, Vice President, and Mr Iyad Al-Rafidi, Secretary, while IMET2000-Pal was represented by Dr Fady Zaben and Mrs Alia Taradeh.



IMET2000 Conducts Two BLS Training Workshops to Enhance Life-Saving Skills among Healthcare Professionals

IMET2000-Pal conducted two Basic Life Support (BLS) workshops in July 2026, engaging 18 healthcare professionals and providing practical, hands-on training to enhance their ability to respond to critical situations.

The training focused on building both knowledge and practical confidence in managing emergencies. Participants received hands-on practice in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) for adults, children, and infants, along with training in the safe and effective use of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs).

The first workshop took place on 13 July at IMET2000-Pal Training Centre in Ramallah, while the second session was held on 26 July at Friends Medical for Health Creativity Centre in Nablus.

Both workshops were delivered by instructors certified by the American Heart Association (AHA), ensuring participants received up-to-date, standardised training aligned with international guidelines.
