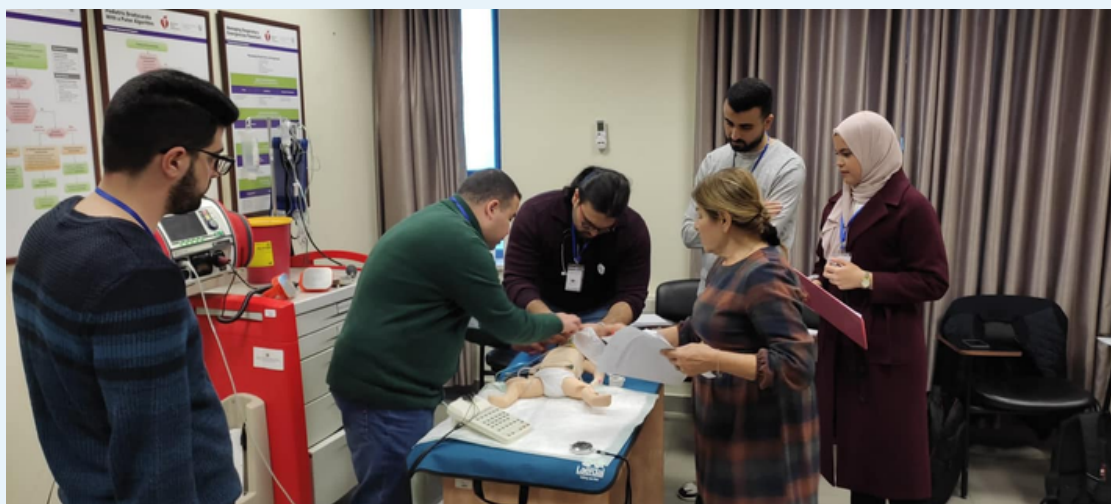
IMET2000 Held Pediatric Advanced Life Support Training Workshop at An-Najah Training Centre

Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) Provider Training for Doctors and Nurses

The workshop was attended by 5 Participants from different governmental and private hospitals at An-Najah Training Centre-Nablus. This workshop aims to discuss the important issues regarding PALS, mentioning the updates of American PALS, 2020, the practice of the pediatric systematic approach, the practice of high-quality CPR (Basic Life Support) for paediatrics, giving respiratory and cardiac emergencies and early interventions. Finally, shows Multi-rescuer resuscitation and team dynamics.

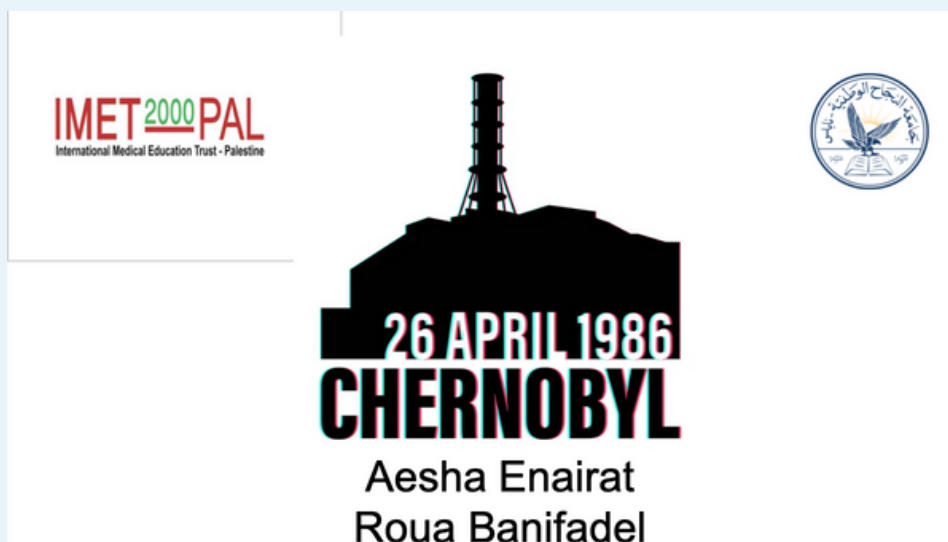
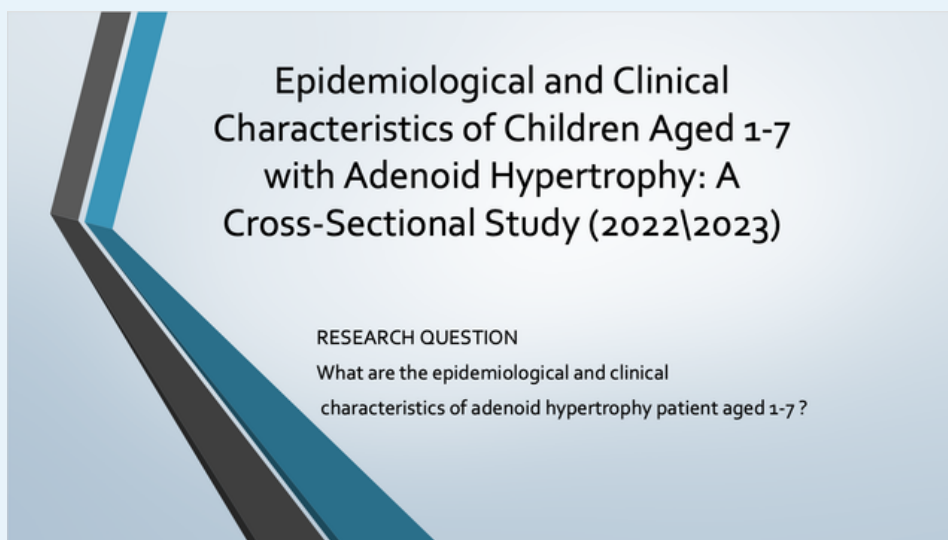
