This workshop was led by Mr. Ayman Anaya (American Heart Association “AHA”) Instructor.



Basic Life Support Training

January 30, 2020

IMET2000-PAL in cooperation with American Arab University-Jenin organised the Critical Core Training: Basic Life Support (BLS) for nurses.

The workshop was attended by 10 nurses from primary health care center and Jericho governmental hospital at Jericho. This workshop was led by Mr. Fayez Ghannam (American Heart Association “AHA”) Instructor.





In line with the strategies of IMET2000 and our interest in mental health for children, we conducted three art therapy sessions as part of our art therapy program in cooperation with An-Najah University Hospital. The total number of children attending was ten. The sessions were as follows: The first was held On 5/1/2020; activities included two girls from the isolation department with psychological depression, where they benefited from the art therapy session by drawing the four seasons with watercolors for exercising and moving the muscles. The second and third sessions were held on 11/1/2020 and 25/1/2020 respectively; activities included performing exercises for simulated stories to develop the child's imagination with a presence of a clown to provide a happy environment.
