IMET2000-Pal sponsors 2 Palestinian psychiatrists to attend ESME & AMEE 2016 in Barcelona

We have sponsored Drs Samah Jaber and Mahmoud Khrishi (Palestinian Psychiatrists) to attend the annual meeting of the Association of Medical Education in Europe (AMEE) which took place in Barcelona, Spain (August 26th-31st, 2016). Both Drs also attended world state of the art course on medical education (ESME). Through this sponsorship IMET2000 aims to establish a focal group of medical educators particularly in the field of psychiatry training. The team was also joined by our CEO, Dr. Malik Zaben, who attended the workshop on computer-assisted learning. Dr. Zaben met the Palestinian guests and discussed with them the future plans of IMET2000 in developing the psychiatry training in Palestine.



International Medical Education Trust organizes a medical research methodology workshop for doctors and medical students

IMET2000-Pal /Medical Education Department, organized a workshop in medical research methodology which was held at the Caesar Hotel/ Ramallah, and was attended by 22 participants. The workshop began with a speech by Dr. Ahmad Hmeedat/ Medical Education officer at IMET2000-Pal, where he welcomed the participants, then talked about the outlook and the role of IMET2000-Pal in developing training in the health sector in Palestine. This workshop was moderated by Dr. Malik Zaben / CEO of IMET2000 / Clinical lecturer and researcher in Neurosurgery / Cardiff University/ UK, where he started by giving a brief explanation about research and the differences between the research and the clinical audit. Dr. Zaben then continued by talking about the way of writing a research proposal, selecting a research topic, identifying the types of research efforts and the best way of writing and reading a research paper. At the end, Dr. Zaben thanked the attendance, emphasizing the importance of scientific research in the medical field in the world, and expressing the willingness of the organization to support healthcare professionals and students who are interested in medical research.

IMET2000-Pal sponsored the second meeting for continuing health professional development in Palestine. Under the auspices of IMET2000-Pal, and in collaboration with the Palestinian Ministry of Health we organized the second meeting on pioneering a national strategy for the development of continuing education. This workshop took place in the Education Hall / Ramallah, in the presence of 25 participants from the governmental and private hospitals in addition to other NGOs. The meeting began with a speech for Dr. Amal Abu Awad / Continuing Education officer in the Ministry. Dr. Abu Awad welcomed the attendants and spoke about the importance of establishing a scientific base built on the foundations of future planning. She thanked IMET2000-Pal for embracing this national project which is of great importance for all the divisions of the medical community. Dr. Malik Zaben / CEO of IMET2000, participated in this meeting, where he talked about the IMET2000-Pal vision on CPD and the role of its projects in the development of the health education in Palestine. The workshop was moderated by Dr. Varsen Shaheen. At the start of the workshop, the outcomes of the first workshop were reviewed. The foundations and methods of this project and the establishment of a credit hours system were thoroughly discussed. After that the participants were divided into three groups for discussion of certain topics in this project, which was followed by presentations of each group before. At the end, Dr. Varsen, Dr. Amal and Dr. Malik expressed their optimism of what have been discussed so far in this and last meetings and they thanked all the attendants for their participation and contribution.
