

IMET2000 Supports Children with Special Needs from The Early Intervention Charitable Society

JANUARY, 2021

In alignment with IMET2000's goal of improving the field of mental health, Dr Mohammad Obaidellah representing IMET2000 visited the Early Intervention Charitable Society in Beit Awar, Ramallah, to assess its needs and the support it requires. The Early Intervention Charitable Society is a charity that provides free rehabilitation services for children with disabilities from 18 different villages in Palestine. Their services include early detection of disabilities, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy and therapy for children with learning difficulties, all of which positively affect the Palestinian public and society. The CEO of IMET2000, Dr Malik Zaben stated that IMET2000 is working to promote early intervention by providing material support to assist in treating the children. He also emphasised the importance of this treatment, as it gives children a better chance to have a brighter future.



IMET2000 Organised a Training Workshop on Clinical Audit at the Palestinian Medical Complex

DECEMBER 27, 2020

IMET2000 organised a training workshop on “Clinical Audit” at the Palestinian Medical Complex in response to calls from surgical trainees and specialists. This workshop came under the title of Clinical Audit for Healthcare Providers. This workshop is one in a series of others to follow as part of our programme. It was held at the Palestinian Medical Complex and attended by 23 surgeons in the presence of the Head of Department Dr Abdul Latif Khader. At his welcome note, he emphasised the importance of clinical audits for those involved in the medical sector in Palestine. IMET2000’s CEO Dr Malik Zaben ran the workshop where he began by describing the importance of medical research and clinical audits in Palestine, and their role in facilitating diagnostic procedures for patients in the future. He also emphasised how highly valued this and announced the lunch Palestine Research Club. This club is going to be the first of its kind in the region and aim to promote research initiatives in Palestine. To conclude, Dr Zaben stated his appreciation for the doctors that attended, and how this session among the rest that will follow, will contribute to improving the medical sector in Palestine. IMET2000 has made developing medical research and clinical audits for medical personnel in Palestine as one of its top priorities for the year 2021.

JANUARY 11, 2021

IMET2000-Pal in cooperation with American Arab University-Jenin organised the:

Critical Core Training: Basic Life Support (BLS) for Physicians and Nurses

from Al-Askari governmental hospital – Nablus at American Arab University-Jenin. The workshop was attended by 7 doctors and nurses. This training prompts physicians and nurses to recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations and provide early use of an AED according to American Heart Association Guidelines. IMET2000 Held a Workshop on Advanced Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation in the Arab American University in Al-Rayhan

JANUARY 17&18, 2021

IMET2000-Pal held a workshop covering advanced cardiopulmonary resuscitation that was attended by 6 doctors from different hospitals. It was titled: Advance Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Course for Physicians. The workshop opened with a few welcoming words from Dr Mohammed Obaidullah, where he welcomed the attendees and outlined different events organised by IMET2000 as well as a glimpse of IMET2000's future plans. The workshop was directed by Mr Ashraf Abu Juhaisha a reliable instructor from the American Heart Association. The training involved the use of medical dolls which helped educate the trainees on how to perform advanced cardiac resuscitation on patients that needed immediate aid and allowed them to practice it. This was alongside a scientific and practical explanation provided by the instructors. At the end of the second day, the trainees were assessed to measure their ability in dealing with such cases.





IMET2000 Organised the First Research Workshop under Palestine Research Club Via ZOOM

The key objectives of these sessions are to provide attendees with a good understanding of what research and clinical audits entitle, enable participants to conduct their first research project and then disseminate it effectively.
