This project also aims to facilitate the discharge of patients from hospitals as soon as it is safe to do so, in order to open up more spaces for people with serious symptoms.

Critical Care Training Workshops: Basic Life Support (BLS) for Physicians and Nurses

The three workshops were attended by 40 doctors and nurses from different hospitals in the West Bank and took place in the American Arab University-Jenin, Al-Rayhan and Bethlehem University. This training prompted physicians and nurses to recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilation and provide early use of an AED according to American Heart Association Guidelines.
