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IMET2000 Held Teaching the Teachers Workshop for Healthcare Professionals at Al Ahli Hospital.

IMET2000 in cooperation with Al Ahli Hospital- Hebron, held "Teaching the Teachers" Workshop for healthcare professionals.

The workshop was led by Dr Malik Zaben, IMET2000 CEO, Clinical Lecturer and Researcher in Neurosurgery, Cardiff University. More than 30 physicians consultants and clinical lecturers attended.

The main objectives were to improve participants' teaching skills, checking their performance as teachers and keeping up-to-date and how to be a good teacher.

IMET2000 held Two “Training the Trainers for Future Leader’s (TtT)” Workshops for medical students in cooperation with Osmosis Medical Education Network (OMEN) and Palestinian Medical Students Association (PMSA) via Zoom.

Each workshop consisted of two sessions and attended by the total of 250 medical students from different Palestinian universities including: An-Najah National University, Al Quds University, Islamic University of Gaza and Hebron University.

The main objectives were to introduce those interested in teaching to key principles of education, improve their teaching skills particularly in how to teach in large and small groups as well as in bedside teaching. The workshop was Led by our CEO Dr Malik Zaben an academic neurosurgeon and internationally recognized medical educator, and it comes as part of IMET2000’s effort to promote and develop medical education in Palestine.

The Lecture touched on how to prevent, deal with brain injuries resulting from traffic accidents, falls from height, sports injuries, and others. In the end, Dr. Malik Zaben answered the students' questions.
